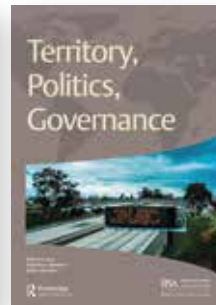

An RSA China Division annual membership offers China based members: online access to 28 academic journals in the field of regional studies and regional science and online and hardcopy access to the RSA's journal Area Development and Policy.

Area Development and Policy (ADP) - aimed at those writing in and on Greater BRICs territories and emerging economies. This journal publishes original academic research examining the multi-scalar and geographically differentiated relationships between economic and political organisation, ways of life and work and their context, as they shape regions, cities, rural areas and their inter-relationships. ADP is indexed in Clarivate Analytics' Emerging Sources Citation Index and Scopus and welcomes suitable paper submissions.

In addition, China Division members have online access to the RSA Blog, the online magazine (e-Zine) *Regions* and have online access to the RSA's Policy Impact Books. Members benefit from research funding opportunities such as the **Early Career Grant Scheme, Membership Grant Scheme (MeRSA), Fellowship Grant Scheme (FeRSA), Policy Expo Grant Scheme, and the Small Grant Scheme on Pandemics, Cities, Regions & Industry**. Members can also apply for Awards (**Nathaniel Lichfield** for recent Masters graduates; the **Paul Benneworth PhD Student Award** or the **RSA Routledge Early Career Award**), access open networks and collaborations, an expert register, reduced members' rates for RSA conferences, discounted publications, a 20% discount off the *Regional Studies Regional Science's* article processing charge (APC) and benefit from an article publishing charge (APC) waiver when publishing in *Regional Studies, Regional Science* mentored 'Student & Early Career' paper section.
